2 06-10-2018 I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for offences punishable under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a) and 37(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 60 litres of country-made liquor was recovered beneath the tree kept in gallons and the petitioners fled away after seeing the police party. It is contended that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners and they have been falsely implicated in the present case. Petitioners claim that they are having clean antecedent and are in custody since



14.08.2018.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioners are directed to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Excise Act, Gaya, in connection with Raushanganj P.S. Case No. 85 of 2018.

If the petitioners, after their release in this case, are again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of their bail bonds.
