ORAL ORDER

2 28-09-2018 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Nanpur P.S. Case No. 75 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under sections 302 and 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that merely on confessional statement of co-accused, petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. and there is no eye witness of the occurrence. Moreover, similarly situated co-accused has been granted bail (Annexure-2) by a different Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 17.07.2018 passed in Criminal Misc. No. 29340 of 2018. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent and is in custody since 06.07.2018.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sitamarhi in connection with Nanpur P.S. Case No. 75 of 2018.
