2 10-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel for the State.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that though the case is quite old, the summonses were never served upon the petitioners. It is further contended that none of the ingredients of the offences punishable under Sections 420, 465 and 468 of the Indian Penal Code are attracted to the facts of the present case.

Learned counsel for the State opposed the application for grant of bail to the petitioners.

Considering the nature of allegation, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks



from, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of S.D.J.M., Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Complaint Case No.800 of 1997 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
