02/ 06.10.2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Rani Talab P. S. case no. 224/2018 registered under section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

The first information report reflects that when inspection of the shop of the petitioner was made by the informant, he was found absent and the food grains as well as kerosene oil had been kept in his house and not on the place which has been mentioned in the licence.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, it is ordered that in the event of arrest/ surrender within six weeks from the date of



receipt of this order to the concerned court, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri P.K.Malviya, Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Danapur in Rani Talab P. S. case no. 224/2018 subject to condition as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
