ORAL ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner seeks bail in **Bandeya P.S. Case No. 16 of 2018** registered for the offence punishable under Sections 323, 379, 308, 498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of torturing the complainant/Informant for non fulfillment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner is husband and has been falsely implicated in this case. It has been further submitted that petitioner never demanded dowry or subjected Informant to cruelty. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner is ready to keep his wife with full dignity and honour but the complainant/informant is not interested. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and is in custody since 13.07.2018.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate-Daudnagar, Aurangabad** in connection with **Bandeya P.S. Case No. 16 of 2018**, with following conditions:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and his absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will be sufficient to cancel his bail bond.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
