2 06-08-2018 Despite service of two advance copies to the Advocate General on 25.8.2014 till date no counter affidavit has been filed on behalf of the respondents.

The issue involved in the present writ application is payment of salary.

It appears from the pleading that the matter was taken to the District Teachers Employment Appellate Authority and the Tribunal has passed order in favour of the petitioner in Appeal No. 23 of 2013 vide order dated 23.12.2013 yet the respondents have not paid salary to this petitioner.



Under the aforesaid circumstances, the writ petition is disposed of with direction to the respondent, District Programme Officer(Establishment), Gopalganj to ensure payment of salary in the light of the order passed by the District Teachers Employment Appellate Authority in Appeal No. 23 of 2013 dated 23.12.2013 within a period of four months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition stands disposed of.
