2 26-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Malaypur P.S. Case No.
41/2018, instituted for the offence under Section 392 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that
petitioner is driver of the truck, which has been looted by
unknown persons. The written report has been lodged by owner of
truck levelling allegation against this petitioner that he did not
give satisfactory reply on mobile phone about looting of the
articles of truck. It is further submitted that truck has been
recovered from the area of Dumri Police Station under Giridih
District (Jharkhand) on 07.06.2018. In this manner, mere



suspicion has been raised by informant against this petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamui in connection with Malaypur P.S. Case No. 41/2018, subject to the conditions that both the bailors shall be the close relative of the petitioner.
