APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 307, 325, 448 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case, in short, is that the accused persons, variously armed, assaulted the informant and his family members due to which they sustained injuries.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioners. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in the



present case. The petitioners are ladies. General and omnibus allegation has been made against the petitioners. No specific over act has been alleged against the petitioners. There is a case and counter case between the parties. The injury on the accused side has not been explained by the prosecution. The prosecution has not come with clean hands.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the F.I.R./complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. 1st, Madhubani in connection with Raj Nagar P.S. Case No. 189 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
