Petitioners seek bail in **Jaynagar P.S. Case No.430 of 2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 379 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are not named in the First Information Report. No Test Identification Parade has been held. Nothing incriminating article has been recovered from possession of the petitioners. Name of the petitioners has been disclosed by co-accused Vikash Kumar in his confessional statement.

Petitioners are in custody since 06.08.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of



the petitioners for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Madhubani**, in connection with **Jaynagar P.S. Case No.430 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioners.
