Petitioner seeks bail in **Laheriasarai P.S. Case No.328 of 2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 401, 413, 414, 467, 468 and 471 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no recovery of any stolen motorcycle from his possession. Name of this petitioner has been disclosed before the police by Vishwajeet and Balram, who told before the police that they used to sell stolen motorcycles to this petitioner.
