2 13-12-2018 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Araria PS case no. 526 of 2018 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 414/34 of Indian Penal Code.

The allegation is regarding recovery of a motorcycle
said to have been stolen one from the possession of the
petitioner and the co-accused persons when they were fleeing
away, upon a checking being conducted by the police.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that till
date, the police has not been able to show that the motorcycle
was a stolen one and further, the motorcycle was not recovered
from the possession of the petitioner. Lastly, it is submitted that
the petitioner is having a clean antecedent and he is languishing



in custody since 10.08.2018.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the abovenamed petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria in connection with Araria PS case no. 526 of 2018.
