The petitioner assailed the constitution of an inspecting team by the Health Department, Government of Bihar through Memo No. 112(6) dated 13th of February, 2017 for



inspecting nursing training school/institutions.

The Court had the occasion to consider similar aspect in CWJC No. 3274 of 2017. It appears that no inspection was ever conducted by the said inspecting team. Further the said inspecting team was required to submit a report by 25.02.2017 itself.

The writ application in my view has lost its significance and it is accordingly disposed of .
