ORAL ORDER

2 21-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in
connection with G.O. No. 743 of 2018 arising out of Singhwara
P.S. Case No. 171 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable
under Sections 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation against petitioner and other co-accused
is of recovery of 4,627.44 litres of country made foreign liquor
from the truck which was parked near Dal Mill of co-accused.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
he is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case.
Petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
24.08.2018.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of



the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 4th Additional Sessions Judge – cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Darbhanga, in connection with G.O. No. 743 of 2018 arising out of Singhwara P.S. Case No. 171 of 2018 subject to the conditions that:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be represented on each and every date fixed by the court.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.

(4) If the petitioner is found involved in similar nature of offences, after his release on bail the trial court shall take steps to cancel his bail bond.
