The only order passed in the writ petition on 15.2.2010 in C.W.J.C. No.9883 of 2006 was a direction to the Vice Chancellor of the University to consider and take a decision with regard to the representation of the petitioner. The Vice Chancellor has taken a decision and passed an appropriate order granting certain benefits to the petitioner.

Now the grievance of the petitioner is only with regard to grant of interest on the delayed payment. In the writ petition, no such direction to pay interest was given and, therefore, in this



contempt application no further action is required to be taken.

In view of the above, this application is disposed of.

In case the petitioner has any grievance still subsisting, with regard to non-payment of statutory interest, he may challenge the same in accordance with law in an appropriate proceeding.
