2 24-04-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to file a fresh representation before the respondent No.5 regarding his grievances mentioned in the writ petition and the respondent No.5 be directed to dispose of the said representation within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation regarding his grievances within two weeks and in case such representation is filed before the respondent No.5, then the same may be considered and disposed of within a period of



four weeks from the date of filing of the said representation by a speaking and reasoned order considering the judgment of this Court dated 13.05.2014 passed in C.W.J.C. No.9798 of 2008 and other analogous cases.
