ORAL ORDER

2 20-04-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Brahmpur P.S.Case No.74 of 2018 , registered for offences
punishable under Sections 341, 323, 354(B) and 307/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he was throwing
mud in front of the house of the informant and when she protested,
she was assaulted by him and he also tried to outrage her modesty.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that
they are neighbour and the allegation of outraging her modesty is
ornamental and it is simple in nature.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and



circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Buxar in connection with Brahmpur P.S.Case No.74 of 2018 subject to condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the investigation of the case and make himself available as and when required by the Police, otherwise, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid direction, this application is allowed.
