Petitioners apprehend their arrest in **Warisaliganj**

P.S. Case No.08 of 2018 instituted for the offence under Section(s) 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B Indian Penal Code and Section 66-C and 66-D of the Information Technology Act.

It has been submitted that other accused with similar allegation has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court by order dated 27.03.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No.15411 of 2018.

In the written report, it is alleged that accused, Saket Kumar, was apprehended by the police, who stated that Gautam Kumar was the gang leader and 50 members of his gang used to cheat the persons for providing them gift after obtaining Data



Base of different company.

There is general and omnibus allegation against these petitioners.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioners, named above, within six weeks from today in connection with **Warisaliganj P.S. Case No.08 of 2018**, they shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, II, Nawada**, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C. with further conditions: (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and their absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will be liable to cancel their bail bonds and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
