Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned

APP for the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in **Complaint Case No.2411 of 2014** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 379, 427/34 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the police after investigation submitted final form in the case, but on the basis of Protest Petition cognizance has been taken against the petitioners for the offence under Section(s) 379, 427/34 Indian Penal Code.

Allegation in the written report is that on the date of occurrence the informant saw the petitioners with other persons, who had cut down 150 Sheesham trees, and on raising alarm



accused persons ran away from the place of occurrence.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioners, named above, within six weeks from today in connection with **Complaint Case No.2411 of 2014**, they shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-cum-Sub Judge VIII, Muzaffarpur**, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C. with further conditions: (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and their absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will be liable to cancel their bail bonds and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
