in view of the ratio of the decision rendered by the Division

Bench in *Bihar Rajya Bhumi Vikas Bank Samiti V. the State
of Bihar & others, reported in 2017 (1) PLJR 285*, no intra
court appeal shall lie against a decision rendered under Article
227 of the Constitution of India.

In view of the said Division Bench decision, which places
reliance on a large number of decisions even of the Hon'ble
Apex Court, the present appeal is not maintainable and,



therefore, the Letters Patent Appeal stands dismissed.

Dismissal of the appeal, however, may not come in the way
of the appellant invoking appropriate jurisdiction.
