APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered under Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a), 30(c), 45 and 47 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution case, in short, is that 1131.840 liters wine is recovered.

There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The name of the petitioner has transpired on the basis of disclosure made by the co-accused namely Shyam Sundar. Except for this, there is no other substantive evidence to suggest the implication of the petitioner in this case. It is alleged that 1131.840 liters wine is recovered



from the truck in question. The truck in question does not belong to the petitioner. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner had no knowledge regarding the alleged incident. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 6th Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Chapra, Saran in connection with Mashrakh P.S. Case No. 2/2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
