Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner being the Dewar is apprehending his arrest in connection with Konch P.S. Case No. 172 of 2017 for the offence registered under Sections 328, 304(B) and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is general and omnibus allegation of torture against all the family members. There is no specific allegation against this petitioner. It is further submitted that husband has already been taken into custody and the father-in-law and the mother-in-law have been extended the privilege of regular bail vide order dated 27.03.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 27.03.2018.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and that there is no specific allegation against this



petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, III, Gaya in connection with Konch P.S. Case No. 172 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
