3 03-12-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed in as much as the account of the petitioner, which was freed earlier, has been released but the petitioner has suffered mental agony on account of being a senior citizen and his pension having been held up without any reason, hence he is entitled for some compensation.

authority for redressal of his grievance regarding him being compensated on account of unnecessary harassment being meted out to him due to his account having been frozen without any reason.
