2 12-02-2018 Heard Smt. Nivedita Nirvikar, learned counsel for the petitioners and Shri Jitendra Kumar Singh, learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

Two petitioners apprehending their arrest in connection with Goh P.S. Case No. 84 of 2017 registered for the offence under Sections 147, 149, 304, 341, 323, 448, 379 & 504 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 have prayed for grant of bail in the event of their arrest or surrender.
