ORAL ORDER

2 06-04-2018 The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Doriganj P.S. Case No. 205 of 2017, registered for offences punishable under Sections 147, 341, 323, 380, 504, 506, 379 and 448 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioners is of assault to the informant and other family members and took away different belongings as well as cash of Rs. 50,000/- and also misbehaved with the daughter of the informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that there is case and counter case between the parties and they have falsely been implicated in this case and though there is allegation of assault but all the injuries were found to be simple in nature



and other allegations are only ornamental in nature.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, let the petitioners above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM – VII, Saran at Chapra, in connection with Doriganj P.S. Case No. 205 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C, as well as subject to the following conditions, it is further subject to the condition that:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioners shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioners shall cooperate in the investigation and make themselves available as and when required by the police and on the event of failure on their part to appear before the police on two consecutive dates



without showing any genuine reasons, the
prosecution is free to move for cancellation
of their bail bonds.
