2 18-05-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned
APP for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered under Sections 498A, 323, 379, 368/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioners is of committing torture upon the victim due to non-fulfilment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioners. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in the present case. Specific allegation has been made against the husband for an offence under Section 368 of the I.P.C. The



petitioners are the father-in-law and the mother-in-law of the victim. The petitioners have relied upon the judgment of this Court in the case of Md. Naimul Haque Ansari @ Naimul Haque Ansari & Ors. Vs. The State of Bihar, reported in 2006(3) PLJR 182.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. I, Nalanda in connection with Giriyak P.S. case No.423 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
