2 19-06-2018 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehends arrest in connection with Mashrakh P.S. Case No. 126 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30 (A), 30, 38 and 41 of the Bihar Excise and Prohibition Act, 2016.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case due to dirty village politics. Nothing have been recovered from the conscious possession of these petitioners. Further the alleged Bolero Pickup Van does not belong to any of these petitioners.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of Additional Sessions Judge VI, Excise, Saran at Chapra in connection with Masrakh P.S. Case No. 126 of 2018 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
