2 17-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks Anticipatory bail in connection
with Complaint Case No. 125C of 2018 registered under
Sections 324, 504, 323, 452, 354(B)/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in
this case due to old enmity in village politics. Allegation against
petitioner is assaulting informant by sword causing head injury.
Nature of injury is simple. It has been further submitted that
occurrence took place on 23.01.2018 but complaint was
lodged on 31.01.2018 without any explanation of



such delay. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of Anticipatory bail is allowed and petitioner named above in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within four weeks from today, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Jamui, in connection with Complaint Case No. 125C of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
