Heard learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner and the
respondent-State.

2 It is submitted by the learned Senior Counsel that the application for compassionate appointment of the mother of the petitioner had been rejected earlier in 2007 on the ground that the services of the father of petitioner were not on regular status and, therefore, petitioner's mother was not entitled to consideration for grant of compassionate appointment. It is pointed out that under order dated 08.09.2015 bearing Memo No 5045, which is Annexure 9 to the reply of counter affidavit filed by the petitioner, the services of the petitioner have been confirmed. It is, therefore, submitted that the



petitioner will make an application on the basis of the above declaration claiming compassionate appointment.

3 Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner, writ petition is disposed of with the liberty, as aforesaid.

4 Needless to say that the application will be considered on its own merit and disposed of by a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today.
