2. 10-09-2018 Heard Sri Birendra Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner. None appeared on behalf of State, however; it was informed by Sri R.B.Roy Raman, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor that this brief has been allotted to Dr. Indihar Kumari, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor, but due to ailment, she has not come Court today.
