2 20-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Begusarai Town P.S. Case No.265 of
2018, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 494,
498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 3/4 of the
Dowry Prohibition Act.

Allegation has been made against the petitioners
that they used to torture the victim for non-fulfillment of dowry
demand.

The petitioners are mother-in-law and father-in-law



of the victim.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the above-named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai, in connection with Begusarai Town P.S. Case No. 265 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
