counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is apprehending her arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 1366 of 2006 registered for offences under sections 498-A of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 & 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Looking to the nature of allegation, let the petitioner, namely, Bhutia Devi, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Banka in connection with Complaint Case No. 1366



of 2006, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. as also subject to condition that whenever the police will call the petitioner for investigation/interrogation, she will remain present and if she would not present herself, the privilege of grant of anticipatory bail shall be deemed to have been canceled.
