APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered under Sections 341, 323, 307, 379, 504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case, in short, is that the accused persons variously armed entered into the house of the informant and assaulted the son of informant. Other son came in rescue was also assaulted by them.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioners. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in the



present case. There is a case and counter case between the parties. Both sides have sustained injuries in course of occurrence. The matter has already been compromised vide Annexure-5 to the present application.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the F.I.R./complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri P. Akaram, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Bagaha, West Champaran in connection with Semra P.S. Case No. 88/2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
