ORAL ORDER

7 17-01-2018 Considering the fact that the Mandamus issued in the writ petition was to pay arrears of salary which has already been paid, now no further indulgence into the matter is called for.

With regard to the remaining observations made in the matter of formulation of Rule, contempt action need not be taken for the present as the matter is to be taken up by the Department before the Supreme Court and thereafter action taken for formulation of Rule, as directed by the learned Writ Court.
