2 11-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Arer P.S. Case No.55 of 2013 for the offence registered under Sections 420, 406/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the entire case is false and fabricated and the story that the petitioners were given money for procuring a job that the petitioners are wholly farfetched and mischievous. It was further submitted that there was no question of return of the money as the same had never been accepted and taken by the petitioners.

Considering the vague nature of allegation and there



being no proof with regard to the money having exchanged hands save and accept the allegation, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of J.M. Ist Class, Benipatti, Madhubani in connection with Arer P.S. Case No.55 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
