Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 272,420,353,188 of the Indian Penal Code and 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The recovery of liquor is from the community hall. It is alleged that the same belongs to the FIR named accused person including the petitioner. Petitioner has stated on oath that he has got no criminal antecedent.

Submission is that the petitioner has no concern with the said recovered liquor.

Let the petitioner, above named, in the



event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000 (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Barbigha P.S.Case No.441 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and further the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
