Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that a revised result has been prepared by the Bihar Sanskrit Shiksha Board and as a consequence thereof fresh certificate has been issued, copy of which has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner in the Court by learned counsel representing the Board.

Learned counsel, appearing on behalf of the Board, has submitted that in view of the observations made by the Court, the results have been revised and the students are



accordingly being communicated about the same. Since the petitioners' grievances has been redressed, this application has become infructuous and it is accordingly disposed of.

It is, however, made clear that the Board must ensure that similarly situated persons are not compelled to approach this Court for similar relief as sought in this writ application.
