Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

106.890 liters of Nepali Saufi wine is said to have
been recovered from the auto and the petitioner was apprehended.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that no incriminating article has been recovered from the
conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has been
falsely implicated in this case by the police merely on suspicion
while he was passing through place of occurrence. He has no



concern either with the seized liquor or with the auto in question.
He has no criminal antecedent and has been languishing in custody since 01.03.2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.D.J.-II-cum-Special Judge Excise Act, Sitamarhi in connection with Case No.C 2-131/18.
