3 24-01-2018 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner, already in custody, seeks bail in connection with Nanpur P.S.Case No. 53 of 2017 registered under Sections 120B, 201 and 302 of the Indian penal Code.

Allegation is that petitioner and the deceased was in friendship and he called the deceased on mobile, thereafter his dead body was found on subsequent day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that except the disclosure of the name of petitioner by one Indrasan Devi, who is said to have made plan and committed murder of the deceased along with the petitioner, there is no other material and besides there is no other motive for committing crime by the petitioner and the police has submitted charge sheet and Indrasan Devi has already been admitted to bail by a co-ordinate Bench of



this Court vide order dated 09.11.2017 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 40498 of 2017.

Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioner, namely, Pawan Shahi, is directed to be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned SDJM, Pupari at Sitamarhi in connection with Nanpur P.S. Case No. 53 of 2017.
