3 16-02-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 30(A), 32(2) and 38 of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Prosecution case, in short, is that 2212.560 liters wine is
recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner is in custody since 07.08.2017 and has got no criminal
antecedent. Charge sheet/prosecution report has been submitted
in this case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses
alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is said to be the
driver-cum-owner of the container, from which 2212.560 liters



wine is said to have been recovered. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C. The petitioner has remained in custody for about six months.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R./complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Muzaffarpur in connection with Excise case No.277 of 2017.
