ORAL ORDER

17 22-02-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner seeks compliance of the order dated 17.07.2014 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 6921 of 2013.

Having considered the various show-causes filed, it appears that the State has paid the dues of the petitioner after considering the arrangement which was made by him.

Learned counsel, however, seriously resists the contention of the opposite party as stated in the show-cause.

Be that as it may, it appears that there is some serious



dispute with regard to the engagement of the petitioner itself.

Under such circumstances, no case under the Contempt of Courts Act is made out.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is given liberty to contest his claims, if at all, tenable under law.

The contempt application stands disposed of.
