3 16-05-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned APP for the State.

Petitioners, already in custody, seek bail in connection with Laukaha PS Case No.12 of 2018, registered under Sections 395 and 397 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted that the common articles were recovered from possession of the petitioners, the mobiles recovered belong to the accused persons, so called recovered items were not put on TIP and identified by the informant, even the petitioners were also not put on TIP but charge sheet was submitted and they have no criminal antecedent.



Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, petitioners above named are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Jhanjharpur in connection with Laukaha PS Case No.12 of 2018.
