ORAL ORDER

2 17-01-2018 Earlier prayer for bail of the petitioner was dismissed vide order dated 11.05.2017, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 22462 of 2017, with direction the court below to expedite the trial.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that he has been in custody for about a year and uptil now trial has not been concluded. However, he fairly submitted that six witnesses have already been examined and the case is pending only for examination of Doctor and I.O.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides, considering the fact that only two witnesses i.e. Doctor and I.O. have remained to be examined, in such view of the matter, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail, this application is accordingly, dismissed.



However, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial and try to conclude as soon as possible even by conducting it on day to day basis as only two witnesses have remained to be examined.

At the same time, D.M. and S.P., Nawada is directed to ensure the production of remaining two witnesses in the trial court on the date fixed so that the trial be concluded expeditiously.
