The petitioner seeks bail in Chandramandih P.S. case
No.102 of 2017 registered under Sections 498A, 304B/34 of the
Indian Penal Code, pending in the court of Sri Sumit Kumar
Singh, J.M. 1st class, Jamui.

Allegation is that the accused persons including the
petitioner committed murder of the sister of the informant due to
non-fulfilment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 11.10.2017 and has got no
criminal antecedent. Charge sheet has been submitted in this
case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged
against the petitioner. The petitioner has been made accused due



to mistake of fact. There is no other substantive evidence to suggest the implication of the petitioner in the present case nor there is any eye witness to the alleged occurrence.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R. He is the husband of the deceased. The onus is upon him to explain the cause of death of the deceased.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to granted bail to the petitioner. The same is rejected. The Trial Court is directed to take all necessary steps to expedite the trial.
