University.

In view of the subsequent change and the conversion of the Rajendra Agriculture University as Dr. Rajendra Prasad Central University, no positive direction can be issued in the present writ application. However, liberty shall be available to the petitioner to approach the State Government for redressal of his grievance. In the event, the petitioner files representation before the Agriculture Production Commissioner, Department of Agriculture within a period of one month from today along with a copy of this order, the Agriculture Production Commissioner will consider the representation



of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of filing of representation.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merit of the case of the petitioner.

With the aforesaid, the writ application stands disposed of.
