Petitioner seeks bail in Amarpur P.S.Case No.62 of  
2016 registered for the offences under Section 379 of the I.P.C..

Allegation as per the F.I.R. is of theft of motor cycle.  
The petitioner was remanded in this case from another case.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is  
that there is no recovery from possession of the petitioner and he  
has been made accused only on the basis of the statement of the  
co-accused in other case and he is in custody since 13.03.2018.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and  
circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named,  
be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- with



two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the C.J.M.,Banka, in Amarpur P.S. Case No.62/16 subject to the conditions that (1) one of the bailors must be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court. (ii) the petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence and the petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of the trial and make himself available as and when required by the court, otherwise, his bail bond shall be cancelled.
