4 20-09-2018 Heard the parties.

Petitioner seeks bail in Pirpanti P.S.Case No.129 of 2018 registered for the offences under Sections 401, 413, 414 of the I.P.C.

Allegation against the petitioner is of recovery of a tractor and tailor from his house.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the said tractor belongs to the petitioner and he is in custody since 23.5.2018 having no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M., XI, Bhagalpur, Pirpainty P.S. Case No.70 of 2018 subject to the conditions that (1) one of the bailors must be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court. (ii) the petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence and the petitioner shall co-operate in disposal of the trial and make himself available as and when required by the court, otherwise, his bail bond shall be cancelled.
