The present writ petition has been filed for the following reliefs –

- (i) For quashing of the entire proceeding of Certificate Case No. 20/2011-12 against the petitioner without complying provisions of the Public Demand Recovery Act for recovery of amount of Rs. 99,309/-.
- (ii) For quashing of the order of Certificate Officer-cum-SDO, Naugachhia, dated 30.07.2012 whereby and whereunder warrant has been issued against the petitioner in complete breach of provisions of the PDR Act without providing notice under Section 7 and without providing objection under Section 9 of the Act.



- (iii) Further for a direction to the respondent no. 3 not to take any coercive measures against the petitioner till decision of this writ petition.
- (iv) And/or pass such other order(s) to which the petitioner is entitled in the facts and circumstances of the instant case.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that his client has taken the file about a year ago in order to forge a compromise with the bank and since then he has no instruction in the matter.

3. The writ petition accordingly stands dismissed.
