Petitioner has filed the present quashing application
for quashing the order dated 20.11.2014 passed in S.C. No. 621
of 2014 for discharge the petitioner from this case in which
cognizance has been taken under Section 498A of IPC and
Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Report of the trial court indicates that already charge
has been framed and the case is fixed for evidence and the stage
of the case has also changed.

Considering the material on record, it is not that no
prima facie case under Section 498A of I.P.C. is made out



against the petitioner-husband of the complainant. Having so,
application is bereft of any merit. Accordingly, it stands
dismissed.
