In view of the decision of this Court in C.W.J.C. No.
17670 of 2017, the University is directed to consider the case of
the petitioner for absorption under Section 4 (14) of Bihar State
Universities Act 1976.

the name of the petitioner figures in letter No. 25 (C). Final decision on the claim of the petitioner for absorption shall be taken by the University within a maximum period of four months from the date of receipt/ production of a copy of this order.
