Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that

petitioner is in custody for more than two years and only one

witness has been examined in th is case.

Heard learned APP and perused the report from which it

appears that two witnesses have been examined and five witnesses

are yet to be examined and learned trial court has sought some

more time.

In such view of the matter, I am not inclined to grant bail

to the petitioner. However, learned trial court is directed to



conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible by conducting it on regular basis.

With the above observation, this application is dismissed.
